Job Summary:

The Production System Manager will be responsible for coordinating all continuous improvement and lean activities in the plant and provide support to production management. This includes training of staff as well as supporting optimized layout and processes for new or refurbished machines and equipment in the plant.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Design, implement and execute the development of Hexagon's Production System within the plant.
- Support, coordinate and execute all improvement projects in the plant.
- Drive the implementation and updating of standards for processes.
- Adhere to standards by process confirmation and sustainable problem solving.
- Provide instruction and training for plant personnel on the Company's Production System; focused on Lean Manufacturing for improving effectiveness and efficiency.
- Secure "Good Practice Sharing" and collaboration within the global Hexagon Production System network.
- Collaborate with cross functional teams locally and regionally on project plans, cost estimates, and data collection/reporting.
- Ability to work with both internal and external resources, prepare and negotiate fees, review change requests and develop schedule and delivery plans.
- Follow all guidelines as well as legislative rules (company values, standard operational procedures, etc.).
- Other duties as assigned.

Supervisor Responsibilities:

Position will supervise all continuous improvement activities in the plant.

Education, Certifications & Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or related discipline.
- Plus, 3 years of experience with lean manufacturing, continuous improvement and production systems required.
- PE License and/or an MBA preferred

- Must have prior experience training others in a Lean Manufacturing Environment.
- Must have strong problem-solving skills and a desire to create solutions.
- Must be efficient and effective in time, quality and cost management.
- Strong ability to influence others to meet deadlines, perform above others and excel in their role.
- Must have demonstrated and effective interpersonal, oral and written communication skills with the ability to professionally interact with internal and external customers.
- Working knowledge of ISO 14001 / OHSAS 18001, ISO 9001, IATF 16949.
- Methods-time measurement (MTM) experience and production system knowledge.
- Demonstrated experience with TPS implementation.
- Must have above average MS Office skills.
