Duties and Responsibilities:

- Manage specific customer development and investment projects from beginning to end.
- Establish and implement project objectives, scope, budget and delivery schedule.
- Lead and coordinate project teams during execution, according to schedule budget, quality and deadlines.
- Provide strong communication and reporting to others and initiate change management when necessary.
- Execute requirement analysis based on customer and market demands.
- Effectively troubleshoot and resolve issues as they occur; anticipate/forecast situations.
- Verify solutions that have been identified through feasibility studies, i.e. K-FEMA, P-FMEA
- Other duties as assigned

- Prior experience working under tight deadlines with shifting priorities
- Ability to execute projects according to company policy and procedures

- Prior polymer and/or composites technology preferred but not required.
